<p>A video of Ryan making a mistake during a class presentation is posted online along with a caption making fun of him. The video gets shared widely, and people start commenting and laughing at him.</p>	<p>A fake story is posted online claiming that Noah cheated during an important college exam. Even though the story is completely false, it quickly spreads, and Noah starts receiving hurtful messages from classmates and even tutors who believe the rumor.</p>
<p>A group of friends creates a new private social media group, intentionally excluding one of their friends, Max. They start posting pictures and inside jokes, making sure Max can see what he's missing out on.</p>	<p>Sarah receives a series of anonymous direct messages (DMs) on social media, attacking her for her beliefs and appearance. The messages become increasingly aggressive and threatening.</p>
