Prompt Cards

<p>Discussion prompt card 1:</p> <p>The video shows a young male suspected of suffering from a drug overdose and is being given CPR by a police officer. Think about your chosen character (either the person given the CPR or Taylor, the drugs supplier)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you think may have led up to this point? • Think beyond the last few hours; think about the last weeks or months, or possibly even years, that have led up to this. Make up a 'story' or 'back story' about your given character and describe this: write this down on your sheet. • You may want to think about things like his relationships, family members, siblings, parents, home environment, health and wellbeing, friends, friendship groups, peer influence, interests, hobbies, music likes, etc. • Which one of Taylor's customers might end up needing CPR; the person from the deals at school? In the park? On the street? Or the house party? Add this to your story. 	<p>Discussion prompt card 2:</p> <p>This expands upon the previous back story:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who else is involved in the person being given CPR? • Discuss as a group who else is present and how they might be affected. • Think about how they ended up being there? Did someone ring them? Were they already around or involved in some way? If so what/ how? • Does Taylor know what happened? Would someone contact Taylor and let him know? Were there any witnesses to what happened? • What might Taylor be thinking about or doing now if he knows what has happened?
<p>Discussion prompt card 3:</p> <p>Add these questions to your story and how/ who/ what else is affected</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss who else might be affected by this? • Think about who else might be involved in your chosen characters life. Who might they be and how have they been affected so far? Afterwards? • Decide how this ends; does the person receiving CPR survive and recover or not? How might others in your backstory be affected by this outcome? Friends? Family? Witnesses? How might they feel? • What could be some of the long-term impacts? We see the Police arriving at Taylors home, what do you think happens next? 	<p>Discussion prompt card 4:</p> <p>Think about your backstory and discuss in your group: What points could things have happened differently to avoid the person needing CPR?</p> <p>See if you can come up with at least two things that might have stopped the person having an overdose and needing CPR. Write these down.</p>
